## What is the St. Louis Coalition on Addictions?

The initiative to bring together individuals concerned about alcoholism and other chemical dependencies was begun in 1976 by the National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (NCADA) – St. Louis Area. The goal was to build a self-supporting coalition with a major focus on addiction issues. Today, **the St. Louis Coalition on Addictions** provides a forum for discussion, learning and advocacy on alcohol, drug use, abuse and other addictions.

### Goals of the Coalition

- Promote and provide training opportunities through guest speakers, workshops, announcements and a calendar of events
- Provide continuing education contact hours from the Missouri Substance Abuse Counselors' Certification Board
- Promote advocacy efforts by providing legislative and policy information related to the field
- Establish advocacy positions to policy makers
- Provide the opportunity to network and learn about the services of prevention and treatment providers
- Offer a vehicle to market job opportunities and other field interests.

### Membership

Membership is open to professionals, lay persons, students, people in recovery, and any other person interested in the prevention and treatment of addictions. Visitors are always welcome.
