

Community Prevention Specialist

This position, based at NCADA's Brentwood office in St. Louis County, requires a BA or MA in community organization, social work, education or a related field, plus experience in coalition building or community development. **Community Prevention Specialists** assist with NCADA projects and events. They also consult with members of coalitions providing activities in their community to prevent substance abuse; advocating for legislative and policy change; conducting community assessments; and writing grants to support their projects. Professionals must be mature, knowledgeable about substance abuse, highly organized, flexible, reliable, adept at public relations, comfortable working with diverse populations, and skilled at writing and public speaking.
